[Maldives](#) has purchased Bayraktar TB2 unmanned aerial vehicles from Türkiye to strengthen its national security and surveillance missions.

[NXP, automotive computer chip manufacturer](#), has announced a new platform that makes it possible to standardize software development for many of the growing number of electronic systems used in automobiles.



[The US Government](#) plans to employ 100 artificial intelligence experts to promote the safe use of artificial intelligence and requires federal agencies to appoint an artificial intelligence officer within 60 days.

[ASELSAN](#) announced that the indigenously developed active electronically scanned array (AESA) radar performed its first flight on the Lockheed Martin F-16 Fighting Falcon fighter jet of the Turkish Air Force on 16 March.

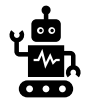
DEVELOPMENTS FROM PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS REGARDING TECHNOLOGY
